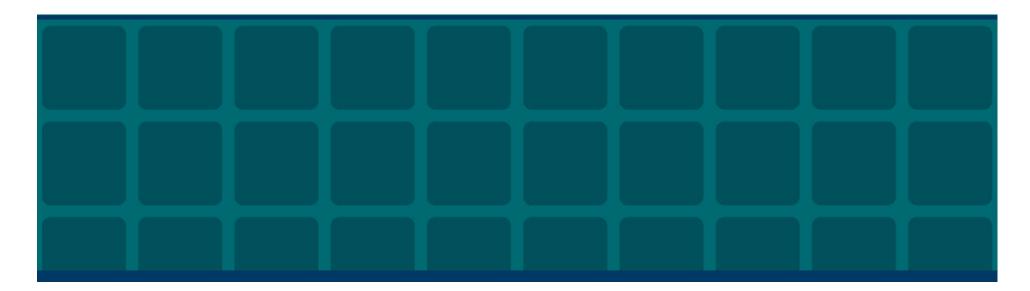

### What is open e-Parliament?



Legislative proceedings and meeting information, ALL open to the public

e-Parliament



Satisfies the public's right to be informed



Grants the public unrestricted use of the information






