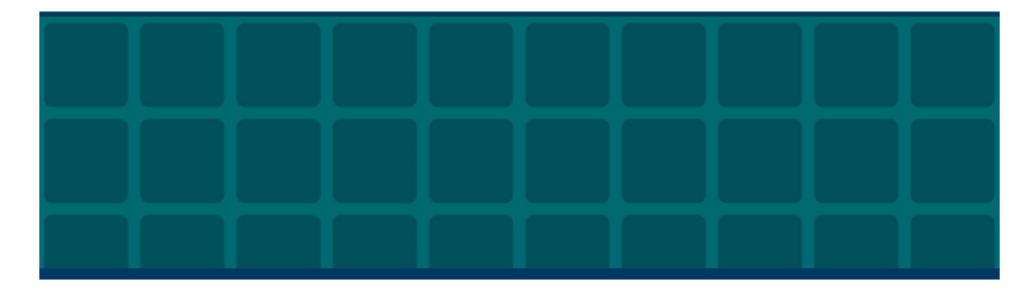








Entire Development






