



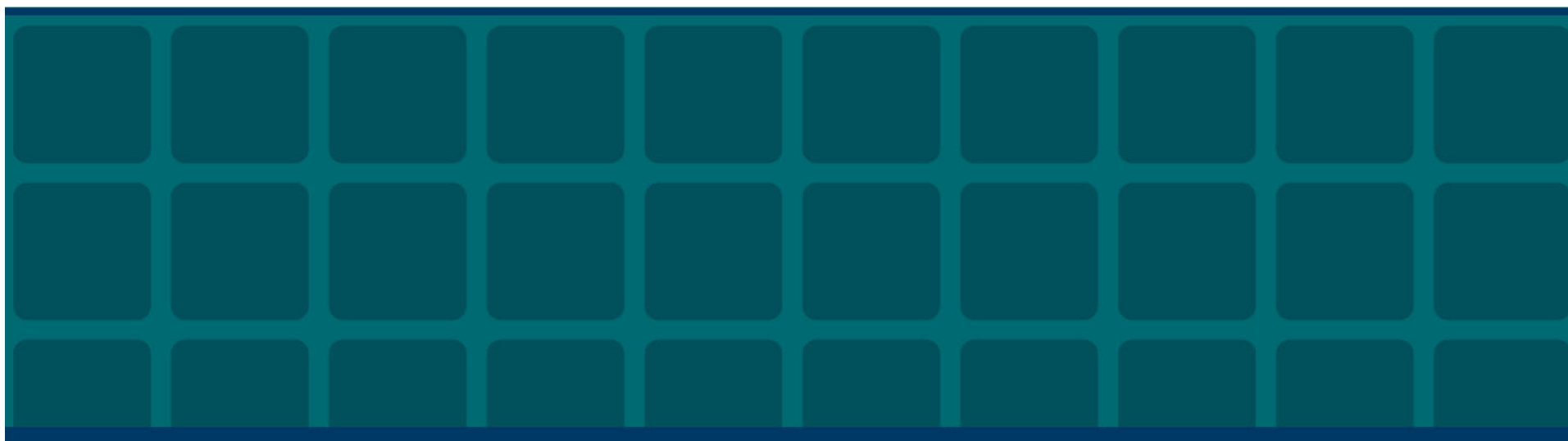

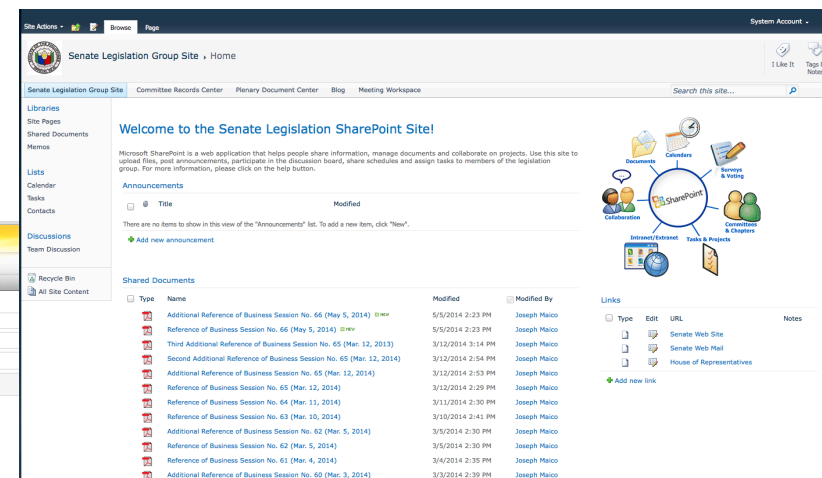
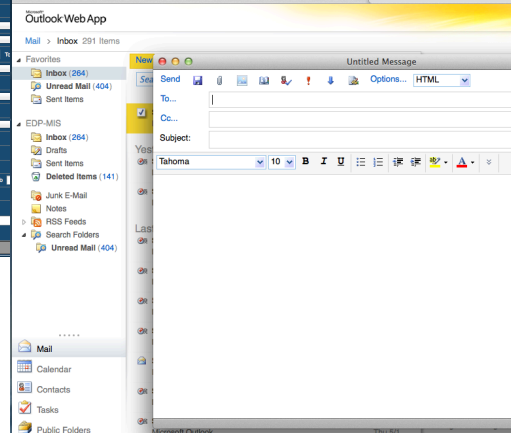

Be it enacted by the Senate and the House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

Section 1. Declaration of Policy. – The following are hereby declared to be the policies of the State:

1. The State shall ensure compliance with the 1978 International Convention on Standards of Training, Certification, and Watchkeeping for Seafarers (STCW Convention), as amended; all international agreements implementing or applying the STCW Convention; and

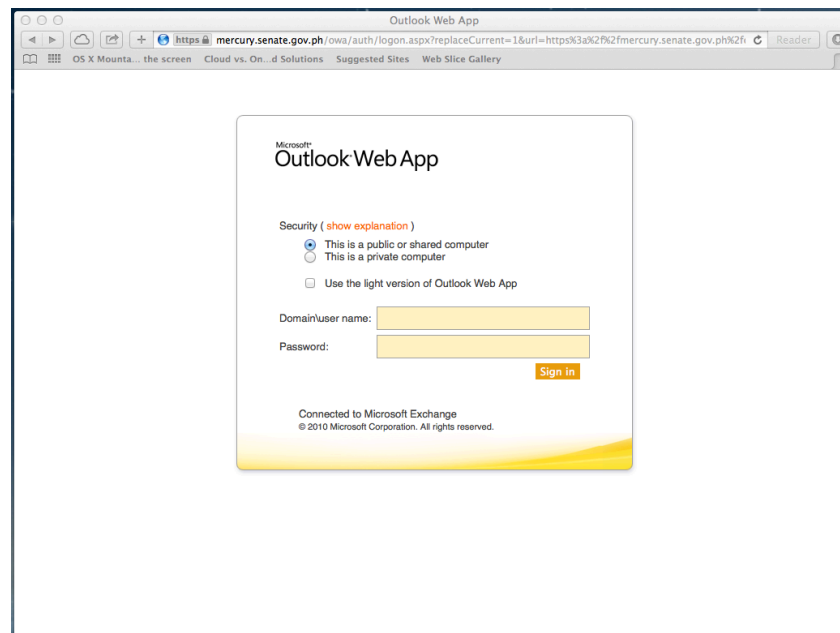
